SMARTBOARD TECHNOLOGY EXPANSION:


Due to the generous outpouring from the Fund -A -Need at the Green and Gold Dinner, we have purchased a Smartboard for the Preschool Room. We hope to have it installed before the end of the year. This completes every room from Preschool-Grade 8.

Through the innovative Technology use, children are more engaged in the learning process. With the internet capabilities, it allows teachers to access the most current information in all areas of the curriculum.

We can project the stories from the reading program. The children can participate more fully in the lessons.

In the areas of Math and Science, teachers can have students work individually or in pairs on math strategies such as graphing, fractions, and computation. Science demonstrations for labs are enhanced by seeing a real model on the screen. Teachers can enlarge images such as cells in science or maps in geography.

At St. Rita, our teachers work continuously to find new ways to support all of our learners.
